We welcome visitors with special needs of any kind and have years of experience working with groups with learning or physical disabilities.

There is a **disabled-accessible toilet** on the ground floor.

Our **lift** gives internal lift access to all floors, including the cafe.

However, pending funding, we regret there is no alternative to the **six steps up to the front door**, with handrails both sides.

Disabled parking

There are spaces for Blue Badge-users in Turner Street and Brick Street, both facing the Buddhist Centre front door.

Loop systems

Both shrine rooms are equipped with loop systems for hearing aid-users.

In the Sense UK Awards 2005 the MBC was commended for its services to the deafblind community. Our community includes a deafblind woman and many others with physical disabilities, many of whom are training for ordination.
